Course Description/Objective:

- This class is designed as a self-study course implementing Study Island's credit recovery program. Your role here is to be successful in attaining the credits necessary to graduate from high school. You must complete the assignments and tests which are aligned with the State educational standards. You will do this by adhering to the published schedule and lessons which fit your area of study.

Units of Study:

The course is inclusive of:

- **World History A** (World Religions, Africa, Asia, Europe, Exploration, Industrialism, Imperialism, Revolutions)
- **World History B** (East Asia, Latin America, Europe post 1815)
- **US History A** (Industrial Revolution – WW 2)
- **US History B** (Cold War – Globalization)

Students will be assigned units of study that correlate to their individual classes.

Academic Policy:

1. Grades will be based solely upon scheduled tests.
2. The student will have one (1) chance to take the test online. That score will be transferred to the grade book.

- 3. Students are responsible for all work. A published schedule is handed out and as well posted.**
- 4. Tests must be taken on the posted test date, in class, during the class. No phones or other computers may be open while the test is being taken.**
